Our Whole Food Philosophy


Since 1929, Standard Process has been dedicated to the field of nutritional supplements and the whole food philosophy introduced by Dr. Royal Lee. He knew that the health-giving properties of a whole food exceed those of isolated vitamins and minerals. His goal was to provide nutrients as they are found in nature – in a whole food state where he believed their natural potency and efficacy would be realized.

What is a Whole Food Supplement?

Whole food-based supplements generally include foods that are prepared in a way that safeguards their nutritional value. When making our supplements, we start with whole foods like pea vine, Spanish black radishes and beets. The great majority of our plant ingredients are grown locally on our certified organic farm in Palmyra, Wisconsin. This allows us to control the quality of our ingredients *from seed to supplement*®. Our whole food-based ingredients are an important part of our complex product formulas that may also include whole food extracts, specialized protein extracts and concentrates, botanicals, whole food isolates and other ingredients as required to meet our high quality standards.

Our Farm and Way of Life



All Organic Farms Are Not the Same




